POSITION SUMMARY:

The Home Modification and Equipment Installation Technician will be involved with the installation of various types of patient care equipment in a facility or home setting. This can also include basic home bathroom remodeling, door opening widening, and other construction-type functions. Occasionally, based on available installation and project workload, the technician may perform other duties as assigned in other areas of the business such as service work, warranty follow-up, and maintenance inspection service.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Project Onsite Lead to complete the installation of ceiling track lifting systems, stair lifts, vertical platform lifts, ramps, grab bars, handrails, and other miscellaneous patient care equipment
- Perform home modifications in residential setting, with basic carpentry and remodeling skills
- Ability to work with customers and sub-contractors directly to complete projects
- Must have the ability to interact directly with owners and staff at hospitals, nursing homes, private residences, group homes, etc. while performing the above functions
- Train, work with, and oversee others to get projects completed
- Train the end users of the equipment on the operational aspects of the equipment sold and installed
- Keep accurate project records for expenses, man hours worked, various required testing, training etc.
- Maintain the company vehicle in good operating condition, cleanliness, and keep fully equipped

QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE/ABILITY REQUIRED/COMPETENCIES:

- High school diploma/GED, Technical School
- Must have good understanding of building construction w/basic understanding in electrical and plumbing
- Experience with Framing, drywall, finish/trim work, basic plumbing and electrical
- Experience working in commercial new construction environments
- Able to read and interpret written information, instructions, and prints/drawings
- 3-5 years of experience in one or more of the above trades required.
- Valid U.S. Driver's License with minimal driving infractions
- Must be able to regularly lift, push, pull and move up to 50 pounds.
- Must be able to work on a 4'-10' ladders for extended time periods.
- Must be able to travel with occasional overnight stays for possibly up to one week periods at a time
- Commits to long hours of work when necessary to reach goals
- Independent worker, responsible, consistently at work and on time
- Responds to management verbal and written direction
- Independent problem solver and can take responsibility for their own actions
- Able to work above one's head or in attics for extended periods of time
